 - Candidates must then pass the exams for an additional 12 elective topics. Once this is achieved the candidate has earned the CPL (Certified Professional Locksmith) designation.
 - Candidates must then pass the exams for an additional 9 electives. This is the final hurdle in become an ALOA Certified CML (Certified Master Locksmith).
